Beaver Lake Nature Center is offering weekly Nature On Wheels tours, featuring the NOWmobile, a new electric vehicle that will help connect visitors with mobility limits to fascinating natural areas. Each excursion is about a ninety minute tour through the Center's diverse habitats. Accompanied by a naturalist, the NOWmobile will slowly tour through the forests, stopping occasionally to take a close look at interesting features of nature.

Summer tours are offered every Tuesday, from July 1 through August 26 at 10:30 am. The program price is \$2.50 per person. Call Beaver Lake Nature Center at 638-2519 to reserve a seat. Each tour is limited to 9 participants. Group tours are available by appointment only.
