

## Campground Policies:

### PAYMENTS, CANCELLATIONS OR CHANGING OF DATES:

1. Reservations/Payments can be made online ([book.rvspots.com/OneidaShoresPark](http://book.rvspots.com/OneidaShoresPark)) or by calling Park Office (315-676-7366) or Campground Office (315-676-4943) during regular Business Hours (Monday-Friday, 8:30 am-4:00 pm).
2. Payment must be made in full at time of reservation.
3. A minimum one-night fee is non-refundable on all reservations.
4. Changes, cancellations or refunds will not be made unless permit holder notifies park reservation staff in writing at least one week (7) days prior to reservation date.
5. A request to change dates without appropriate (7) day advance notice will be equivalent to a cancellation and will result in the forfeit of all payments.
6. If a change in dates is made within minimum notice period, there will be no penalty and payment/balance will be applied to a new date.

### OCCUPANCY:

1. Check in after 2:00 pm; check out by 11:00 am. Please notify park staff if you will be leaving before 6:00 am.
2. Only campers with reservations will be admitted after 8:00 pm
3. Campsites need to be occupied at night. Please TELL staff if circumstances prevent you from occupying your site overnight.
4. A parent/legal guardian over 21 must accompany all campers under 21 years of age.
5. Maximum occupancy is (6) persons per site; (2) tents per site.
6. Vehicle/Trailer occupancy is limited to (2) license plates per site.

### QUIET HOURS: 10:00 PM TO 6:00 AM

1. All day visitors must leave the park prior to 10:00 pm.
2. Campfires are allowed in designated fire rings only and must be extinguished by midnight.
3. Oneida Shores Staff reserve the right to ask noisy campers to leave the park at any time of day/night.
4. When returning to your campsite after 10:00 pm, please park in the boat launch or beach parking lot and walk to your site.

### PARKING:

1. Campers will receive one permit to park a vehicle (car, truck, boat on trailer, or motorcycle) on the site in addition to RV, camper or tent(s). No more than (2) license plates can occupy a site at any time.
2. NO PARKING OR DRIVING ON THE GRASS.
3. Vehicles must remain on hard surface for the duration of your stay. If vehicles do not fit on the allotted space they must be parked in the boat launch or beach parking areas.
4. Additional permit for parking in the main parking lot will be issued upon request.
5. Visitors must park in the main beach parking area.

### VISITORS:

1. Day visitors are welcome between the hours of 6:00 am and 10:00 pm.
2. Day visitors will be charged regular park admission of \$7 per vehicle during Beach Season.
3. Overnight guests will not be charged, BUT MUST be registered guests in the Campground.

### ALCOHOL:

1. There is a limit of one six pack (or the equivalent) per adult per day.

2. We reserve the right to confiscate excessive amounts of alcohol, or alcohol possessed by a minor.
3. NO Glass containers are allowed.

#### SANITATION:

1. Rest-rooms are located next to site #1; showers are located in the bathhouse buildings located adjacent to the beach.
2. Rest-rooms and showers are kept locked for our campers ease and safety. Combinations for the door locks are given to you upon check in. Combinations should not be shared with the general public.
3. The dump station is located near the entrance to the main parking lot.
4. Please wash dishes, pans, utensils, etc. in the large sinks located outside the campground rest-rooms. Do not use restroom sinks for cleaning anything other than your face and hands.
5. Please do not dump soiled water on the ground at your site.
6. Campers are asked to dispose of their own trash. The dumpster is located across the road from the campground entrance near the boat launch.

#### PETS:

1. Household pets are welcome. Please provide proof of rabies vaccination upon arrival.
2. Pets must be kept in a pen, crate or on a leash (no longer than six feet) at all times while on park property.
3. Please clean up after your pets.
4. Pets may swim off the campground point, or in the Muskrat Bay area. Pets are not allowed on the beach or in the swimming area.

#### ADDITIONAL RULES/GUIDELINES:

1. Swimming and/or wading in the water is only allowed in the designated swim area during open beach hours ONLY. NO swimming and/or wading is allowed at the campground shore or boat launch area.
2. Please observe the 5 MPH one-way traffic flow in the campground.
3. Keep campfires in the fire rings provided. No pallet wood, lumber or construction debris should be burned on park property. Fires must be extinguished thoroughly before leaving your site.
4. Clotheslines may be strung between trees BUT should not interfere with walkways or driving lanes. Be kind to our trees and do not use nails or tacks to hang clotheslines.
5. Please tell us of any problems or safety concerns at your site.
6. For Emergencies, please dial 911.

From NYSDEC: Leave firewood at home, do not transport it to campgrounds or parks. Untreated firewood may not be transported more than 50 miles from its source or origin.
